NEW VICE MAYOR



Hennessey Board of Trustees voted at their regular meeting on Thursday, May 11th making Harold Shaw the Vice Mayor. Shaw was nominated by David Jones, and seconded by Shaw. Jones, Shaw, and Clif Vogt voted yes. Bert Gritz and Randy Bohnstedt voted no. Shaw was elected unopposed in April 2021 for a 4 year term.

The vice-mayor's roll is to act as mayor during the absence or disability of the mayor.

MITCHELL ROAD DRAINAGE MESS

During last week's Hennessey Trustees meeting Bert Gritz said, "In my mind, all that money has been wasted, that project is not going to drain. Everything from 3rd South is going to hold water and be a big mosquito nest. This is how the engineer drew it up." Gritz was referring to the drainage project currently under construction on S Mitchell Rd.



After this week's rain, the entire area that has been completed so far is holding water and not draining. This project is being funded by a grant and has been under construction for about 2 months. Gritz said, "I don't blame the contractor, I think the engineer didn't do it right. I called them yesterday and they kind of blew me off."

There is an area north of 3rd St where the drainage was placed underground

in front of several homes in the 300 block of S Mitchell and it is higher than the new drain system causing a blockage. Several board members agreed to meet with the engineer to discuss a solution.

SCHOOL DRAINAGE PROJECT ON HOLD

Bids were sent out last month for the long-awaited drainage ditch improvement project and were broken into two sections. One for the drainage and another for the parking areas.

Superintendent Jason Sternberger told the school board at last week's meeting that they received bids on the parking area but none for the drainage portion of the project. Sternberger said, "No one wants to bid on the drainage part because there is a large waterline in the same ditch. This has to be moved before placing drainage pipes on top of the waterlines." Sternberger told the board that they need to put the project on hold until he can talk with the town about options.


