The 4th started with a free swim at the Hennessey Aquatic Center.

The Hennessey Lions Club brought back their hilarious Cardboard and Duct Tape boat races that required all boats to be made from cardboard and duct tape only. Entrants were required to launch their boat with two people on board, sail across the pool and back, switch crew members and sail across and back to the finish line. Easier said than done.

The Winners of the race were the Firecracker Team, including Hannah Weaver, Kennes Briley, Quinn Ward, and Jaynie Bennett.

Winners of the Spirit Award for Best Decorated Boat went to the Weaver Two crew, including Mirabelle Bennett, Ethan Click, Elijah Click, and Henley Weaver.

The Titanic Award for the fastest sinker went to The Mercantile Babies, whose crew included Jacee Beaman, Jax Beaman, Piper Zielney and Brant Beaman.

This year's new event was the Lions Club's Ping Pong Ball Race. The club used this as a 50/50 fundraiser. Eight hundred balls were sold and released down the big curly slide. The first one to reach the finish line across the pool won half the pot. The winning ball was 328 Eric Burch (Bryan Burch's brother from California); he won \$400.00.

Eric donated it all back to Hennessey, donating \$200 to the Reserve Angels and \$200 to the Hennessey Lion's Club.

The Hennessey Firefighters held their water wars event, where they battled to see who could push the bucket to the opponent's side. Sort of a tug-of-war with fire hoses. They later turned the hoses straight up and made a giant sprinkler for the crowd to play in.

Following the water wars, the kids got to dig for cash in the sand money mound sponsored by TK Burger Barn.

Food trucks lined up next to the football field, where the crowds enjoyed burgers and treats from the four vendors.

At about 8 pm, spectators gathered in the football stadium and enjoyed music and entertainment from local performers. Ish Ingle, the pastor of the Hennessey First Christian Church, cut off all his hair for a fundraiser for Gage Caulder. They collected \$1345.01 in total. \$541.01 to save it, \$804.00 to save it!

As the sun set, the fireworks show started on the east side of the football field, made possible by the Town of Hennessey and set up by town employees and volunteers.

SCOTT NAMED AS FIRE CHIEF

The announcement came over the fire radio at about 2:45 pm today when the 911 dispatch center congratulated Scott for his new position. INTERIM TOWN ADMINISTRATOR PASSED

Hennessey Board of Trustees met in a Special Meeting Tuesday, June 27th to consider hiring a new interim Town Administrator to fill the position left vacant by David Treanor, the interim Town Administrator.

When Tiffany Tillman resigned last February, David Treanor was named the interim town administrator to fill the vacancy. Treanor said, "When I took the temporary administrator position, they didn't define temporary. It has been four months now." He stepped down from the administration position to return to his regular town jobs, including Parks and Cemetery, Pool, Building inspector, and Flood Plane Administrator. Treanor said, "I just have too many hats!"

The Board returned from a long executive session to consider Nancy Ledford for the temporary position and tabled it with no action or explanation. Ledford recently resigned as the Hobart Chamber of Commerce Director to move to El Reno to be closer to family. Ledford holds a Bachelor of Business Administration degree and a Clerk Treasure Certification.
