

HWY 81 CLOSED FOR SEVERAL HOURS

In the early morning hours of Sunday, March 31st emergency crews responded to a 2 vehicle accident 3.5 miles north of Hennessey on Hwy 81. At about 1 am two pickups traveling north from Hennessey collided sending a black Chevy pickup into the median rolling several times and coming to rest in the southbound lane of Hwy 81. The accident just north of Farmers Electric and just north of E590 Rd blocked the southbound highway while officials routed traffic in both directions using the northbound lane.

Hennessey's LifeEMS checked out all 5 of the occupants and determined there were no serious injuries. None of them were transported and all refused further treatment. The Oklahoma Highway Patrol worked the scene but did not respond for details about the involved or where they were from.



New School Parking Approved

The Hennessey Public Schools Board of Trustees met on Monday. March 25th, for a special meeting on March 25th to discuss the open bids for the paving of 2 parking areas. They decided to move forward with the Base Bid which would create additional parking at the old tennis courts to the north of the football field and the west of the base-ball/softball fields. The bid was awarded to Hembree and Hodgson Construction LLC from Ponca City.

This new parking area will tie into the town-owned parking for the pool to the north and will match in appearance and lighting.

Work is estimated to begin this summer and be completed before the 2024 - 2025 School Year starts. It was decided to hold off on the 2nd parking area south of the Field House along the street fence line. It was discussed that they may be making changes to the football field house that would affect the south parking area so it would be best to hold off on that project for now.

SPECIAL MEETING TO DISCUSS BOARD OF TRUSTEE MEETING DATE CHANGE

To accommodate the attendance of the Town Attorney at board of trustee meetings, a special session was held on Wednesday, March 27, 2024 to consider rescheduling upcoming Regular Town Board of Trustees meetings. During the meeting, concerns were raised about the necessity of the attorney's presence at every meeting, with Mayor Clif Vogt explaining that legal advice and guidance from the attorney were crucial for ensuring the legality of decisions and motions made during the meetings.

Trustee Bert Gritz pointed out that previous town attorneys had attended all meetings for similar reasons. The trustees (excluding Randy Bohnstedt, who was absent) discussed potential alternative meeting dates that would align with the availability of the newly appointed town attorney, Jared Harrison. After considering various options, it was agreed that the second Tuesday of each month would be suitable, although this might conflict with the schedule of Clerk Kelley Vaverka, who works as a shift manager at Love's Country Store.

Kelley expressed her willingness to discuss scheduling adjustments with her employer to accommodate the meeting dates. Despite initial concerns about potential conflicts with her work commitments, it was decided that Kelley would approach her employer to seek flexibility in her schedule. Trustee Bert Gritz emphasized the importance of setting meeting dates based on the town's needs rather than external factors.

To allow Kelley to address the scheduling concerns with her employer, a decision was made to recess the meeting and reconvene for a special session on Tuesday, April 2, at 11:45 am to finalize the future meeting dates. The Town Trustees met again on April 2, and clerk Kelley Vaverka informed the group that her employer would accommodate her schedule. A decision was made to schedule meetings for the 2nd Tuesday of each month.



TOWN SIREN TEST!

The town of Hennessey conducted a test on the new tornado sirens Monday, April 1st at 1:30 pm. Engineers were on site to install the new system and performed a complete test to ensure proper functionality.

While most residents heard the sirens, those in the vicinity of West 1st Street near the new pavilion and Oakwood Drive/Ikes Acres area did not hear them sound.

Currently, two sirens are without power and will not be operational for around two weeks until they are connected.
