Much Needed Facelift

A few years back, I took over the upkeep of Lyon Valley cemetery, which sits 5 miles east and one mile north of Hennessey, across from Union Chapel church. While mowing, I soon noticed many headstones lying on the ground. After pondering over resetting them, I decided to take action. Teaming up with Keith and Shirley Walterscheidt and Mike Witt, we spent multiple half-days fixing nearly 30 fallen stones.

Lyon Valley's history traces back to Mr. Lyon, after whom the cemetery is named. He's said to rest in the northwest corner. In his lifetime he had three wives and 27 children, most of whom have moved away. Families like the Taggarts, Berkenbiles, Hawks, Franklins, and Silvers just to name a few have their loved ones at Lyon Valley, overseen by Tim Taggart.

Over the years, I've maintained various cemeteries, including Calvary Cemetery, with its two Catholic sections adjoining the

town cemetery on north cemetery road and St. Joseph's one east and two south at the corner at N2880 and E640 road at the northeast corner.

Calvary Cemetery holds fascinating stories. Notably, it is the resting place of a woman who played a flute solo in "Schindler's List" and Gary Jo Hajek, many of us could tell a lot of funny stories about him. Gary played a crucial role in replacing an old broken crucifix with a new one donated years ago by a senior member of the Potasea family. If you look closely you will find that the new crucifix has it's eyes open which is not very common.

While mowing at St. Joseph's one day, my wife Glenda discovered her grannie Newell had three siblings buried there that she did not know about.

On Memorial Day, it's important to honor our departed family members. Resetting stones and maintaining the cemetery is a small act of respect. Keith and Shirley Walterscheidt, Mike Witt, and I made these repairs out of reverence, aiming to keep the cemeteries beautiful for visitors, especially on this significant day. We're moved by the colorful flowers placed in remembrance and take pride in serving our community with dignity.

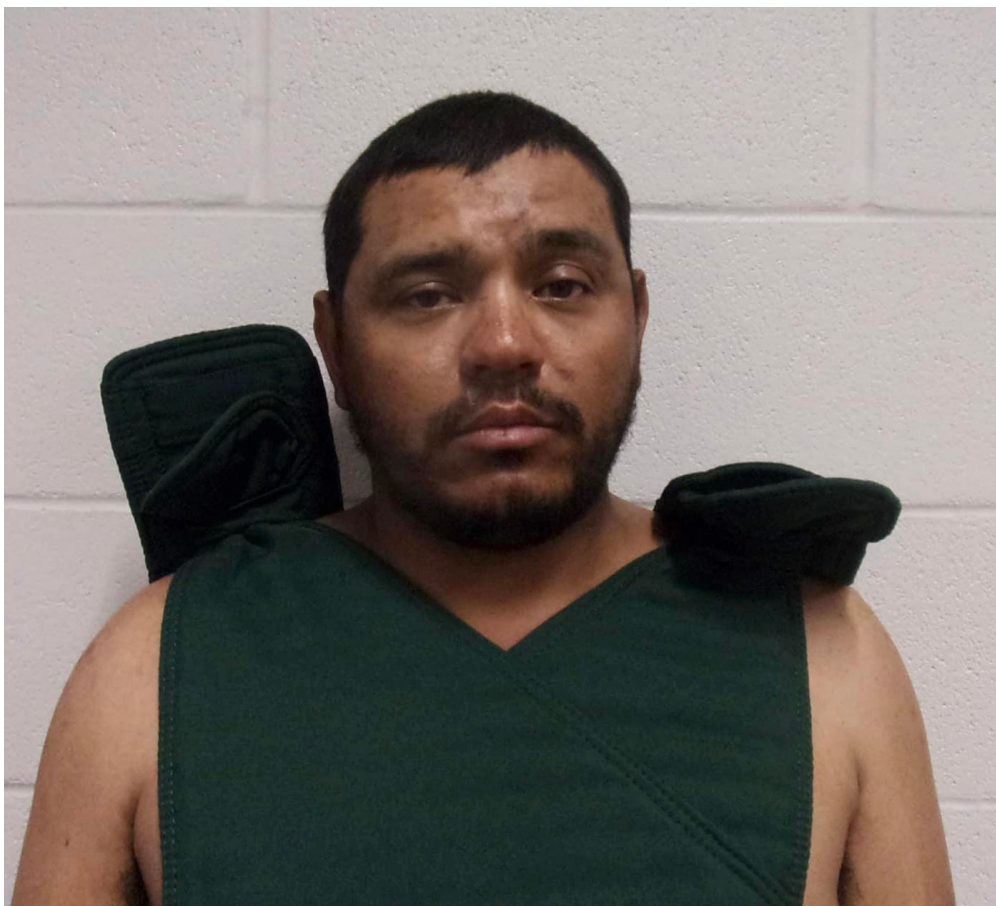

OSBI INVESTIGATES HOMICIDE IN DOVER

Dover - Jorge Maradiago Cruz, aged 37, was taken into custody on a manslaughter charge in connection with the death of a man after a confrontation on Friday evening. The incident, which occurred at 109 S. Chisholm Trail in Dover, was responded to by the Kingfisher County Sheriff's Office at around 9:30 p.m. where they discovered a man who had succumbed to multiple stab wounds, as detailed in a statement posted on the sheriff's office's social media.

Despite efforts by medical personnel to save the victim's life, he tragically passed away at the scene. The Office of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation was brought in to assist with the homicide investigation following a request from the sheriff's office. The suspect was swiftly located and apprehended by deputies, with additional support from law enforcement agencies and the OSBI to secure the area.

Jorge Maradiago Cruz was later booked into the Kingfisher County Jail, according to the OSBI. The deceased individual was transferred to the Office of the Oklahoma Chief Medical Examiner for an examination to establish the cause and manner of death. The inquiry remains active and under investigation, with assistance provided by video footage from 81 Express and collaborative efforts between multiple law enforcement departments and the community to aid in the apprehension of the suspect. Memorial donations made be made in her name to St. Jude's Children's Hospital.

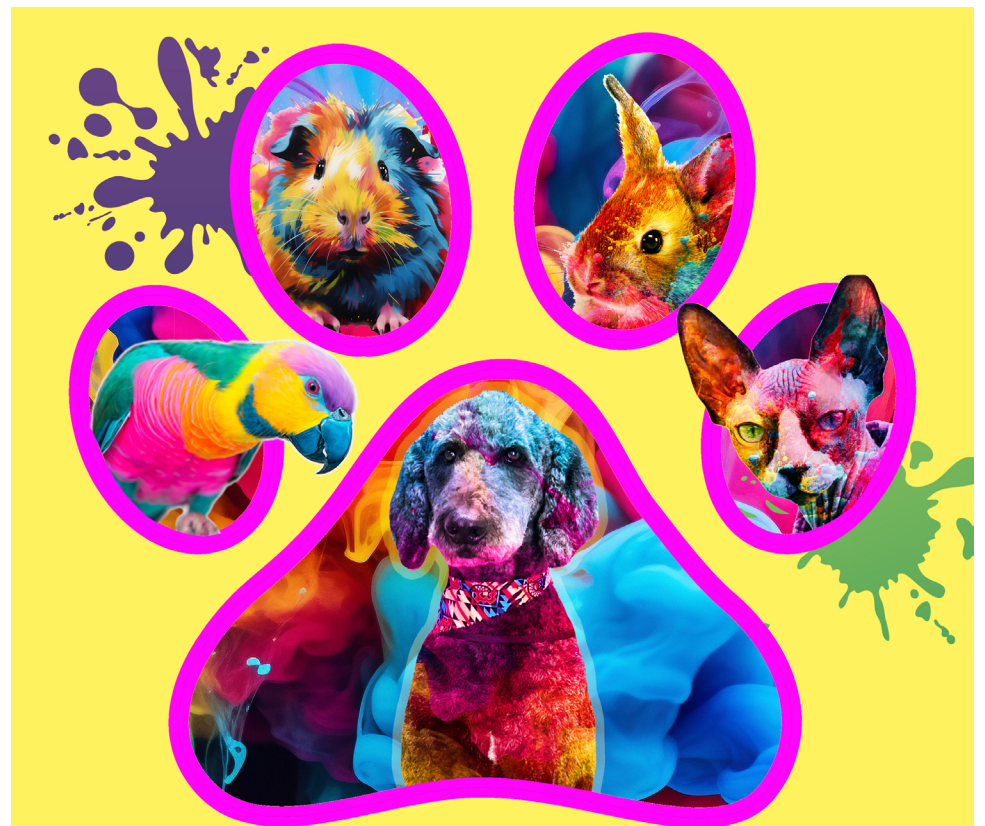


Raising quality meat with care and precision at Decker Beef
