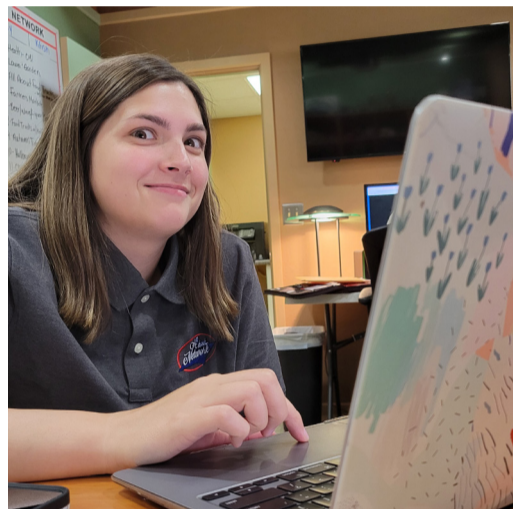
Foreman and Hazen named 2024 State Champion Team Ropers

The Suit brothers, Hazen and Tripp, have been traveling across the country to compete in rodeos, leaving a trail of dust, record times, and an eager determination to get back into the arena for another chance to win it all. The Suit boys are homeschooled due to their busy rodeo lifestyle living in Ames, Oklahoma with their parents, Darin and Shanda, along with their older brother Wyatt. Shanda is a Hennessey graduate and the daughter of Steve and Teresa Oliver. Hazen, a 16-year-

old, Sophomore competes in team roping as a heeler and takes part in the Oklahoma High School Rodeo Association. The high school association holds 20 rodeos throughout Oklahoma from August to May, culminating in a State Finals where the top four year-end competitors in each discipline qualify for the National High School Rodeo Finals. The Oklahoma High School Rodeo Association Finals were held in Chickasha, Oklahoma from May 28 to June 2. Hazen and his team roping partner, Foreman Casebolt from Ryan, Oklahoma, placed in all three rounds of competition, winning the aggregate at the finals, and crowned the 2024 Oklahoma High School Rodeo Association State Champion Team Ropers. They are set to compete at the National High School Finals Rodeo in Rock Springs, Wyoming from July 14 to 20. Hazen has had a passion for being a cowboy and roping from a young age. He competes

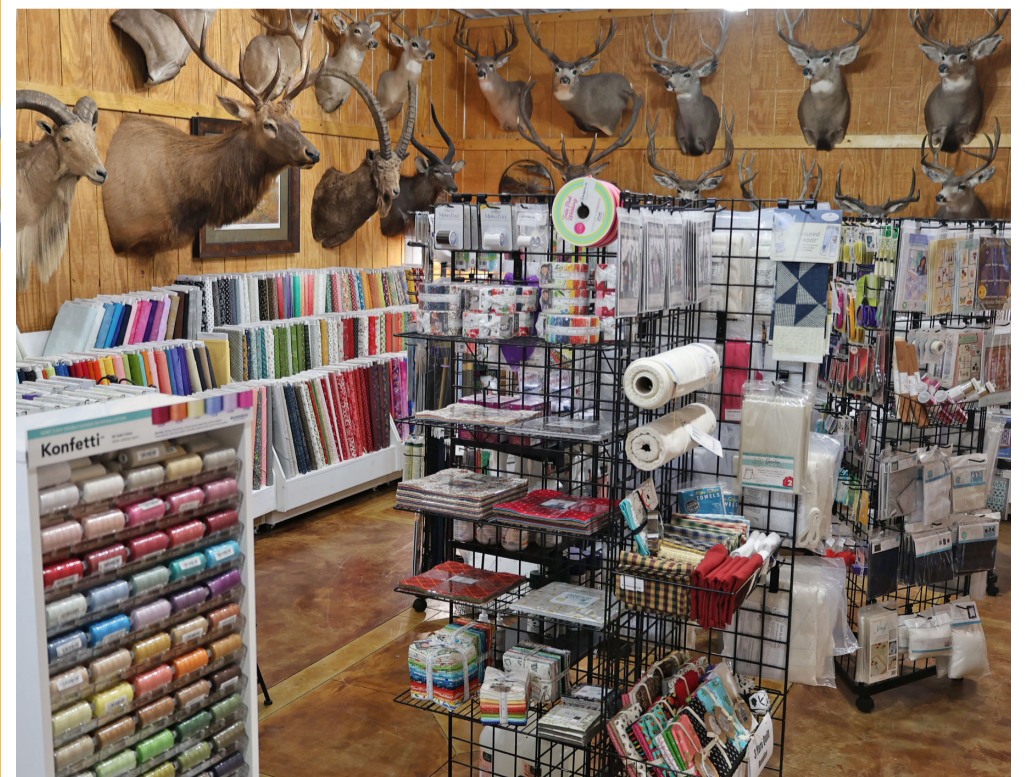
Stitching Together Creativity: The Story of Cozy Quilt Barn and Christi Hawk

Food from your Garden

Garden season is in full swing. Just in case you need another idea to help you use up your bounty; this is a recipe that our Nana made for us when we were young. Super simple and so delicious!

Garden Skillet Dinner

- 1lb ground beef (or ground pork)
- seasoning for meat
- garden veggies (tomatoes, zucchini, squash, onion, peppers, etc)
- rice (cooked)

Brown the ground beef (we used ground pork because that's what was in the freezer) in a large skillet. Season the meat with your preferred seasonings while browning. We like to cook diced onion with the meat so the onions will soften, and we think it imparts the best flavor when cooked with the meat. Favorite seasonings for the meat include garlic, seasoned salt, Cavendar's, and Italian seasoning blend. Season to your taste preference. We also add basil from the garden, picked fresh and chopped.

When the meat is cooked (and drained), add your garden veggies to the skillet; just throw them on top of the cooked meat, it will work, we promise! Tomatoes and sliced zucchini and/or squash are what Nana used to use so are our favorite additions. But really the options are endless here!

Add the sliced veggies to the skillet over the cooked meat and sprinkle some more seasoning over the veggies. Cover with a lid and allow the mix to steam with the lid on over medium heat for at least thirty minutes. Remove lid and stir mixture. If the veggies aren't soft enough for your liking, replace lid and allow to cook longer.

We usually end up allowing it to cook with the lid on over medium heat for closer to an hour (after the meat has been cooked).

You will know it's ready to eat when the veggies are as soft as you want them to be!

In the mean time, while your veggies are cooking, make some rice. Our favorite way to eat this skillet meal is in a bowl over rice.

Garden skillet rice bowls are a little time consuming, only because you need to allow the veggies time to cook, but it so very delicious!! And it is special to eat from your own garden.
