Thick Black Smoke

Hennessey Firefighters responded to a tractor and grass fire Monday, August 5th at 2:16 pm located west of the intersection of NW2920 and EW610 Rd. This is about ¼ mile west of The Union Chapel Church east of Hennessey. When the firefighters arrived, a tractor was attached to a swather fully engulfed in flames, and the field was burning. They quickly extinguished flames that were approaching an oil location. The fire was moving to the north crossed the half-mile fence and entered another field.

Hennessey worked the fire for about 2 hours before declaring it under control and returning to the station at about 5:30 pm.

The rodeo declined in popularity during the '90s and early 2000s. However, in 2005, the Hennessey Roundup Club revived the event, improved the grounds, and hosted a successful rodeo that was recognized as the "2005 Best New Rodeo of the Year" by the Texas Cowboys Rodeo Association. 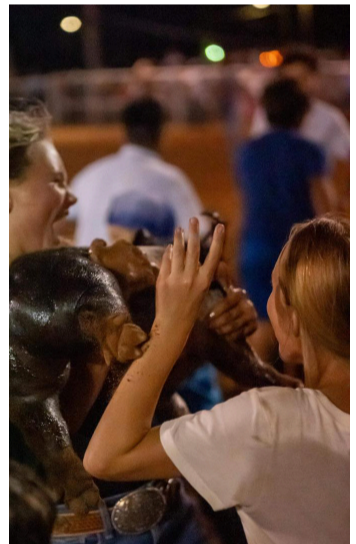

If you don't follow Jeff Bates Art, you're missing out. I had the privilege of visiting with Jeff a few days ago. We reminisced about our classmates while growing up in Hennessey and art! Jeff told me he went to school in Hennessey 2nd, 3rd, and 4th grade, then came back for the 10th, 11th, and 12th grade, graduating with the class of 1977. Jeff is a sculpture artist who credits his high school FFA teacher for teaching him basic welding.

Jeff welded many cattle guards for the oilfield while attending college at Northwestern. He majored in law enforcement and wildlife conservation.

After graduation in 1981, Jeff married another Hennessey alum, Janie Nelson. After many road trips to Colorado, Jeff and Janie moved to Crested Butte, Colorado. Jeff worked for the Forest Service and law enforcement for a few years, but on his days off, he welded things in his shop and sold them locally. Jeff said by the time their son Shelby was born, he had taken a leap of faith and had gone into business for himself. Jeff and Jamie moved their small family to a farming community called Fruita, a suburb of Grand Junction, Colorado, where they reside to this day. Jeff was supplying his artwork to 22 stores in the area. His business grew. The city would put a call for local artists to design something that people would remember long after they left. Jeff stepped up to the challenge. Jeff said he had been fortunate to be chosen for several projects that built his portfolio. Then, he starts the process of studying photos of his subjects. The muscles and preparations. Then, the math starts. Usually, the sculptures are 1.5 life-size. Jeff said he is constantly checking the measurements as he welds. He told me even though many of us are hitting retirement, he's hitting the stride on making someone's junk into a new life. He gives a throw-away and gives it a new form. He said Janie, his son Shelby, and an 88-year-old retired art teacher are his sounding board. They critiqued the work together, and Jeff said he learns something new every day. I could identify with that. I appreciate our art conversation, and I encouraged Jeff and Janie to make a road trip back to Hennessey for one of the all-school reunions at The Gathering Place. I enjoyed our visit!

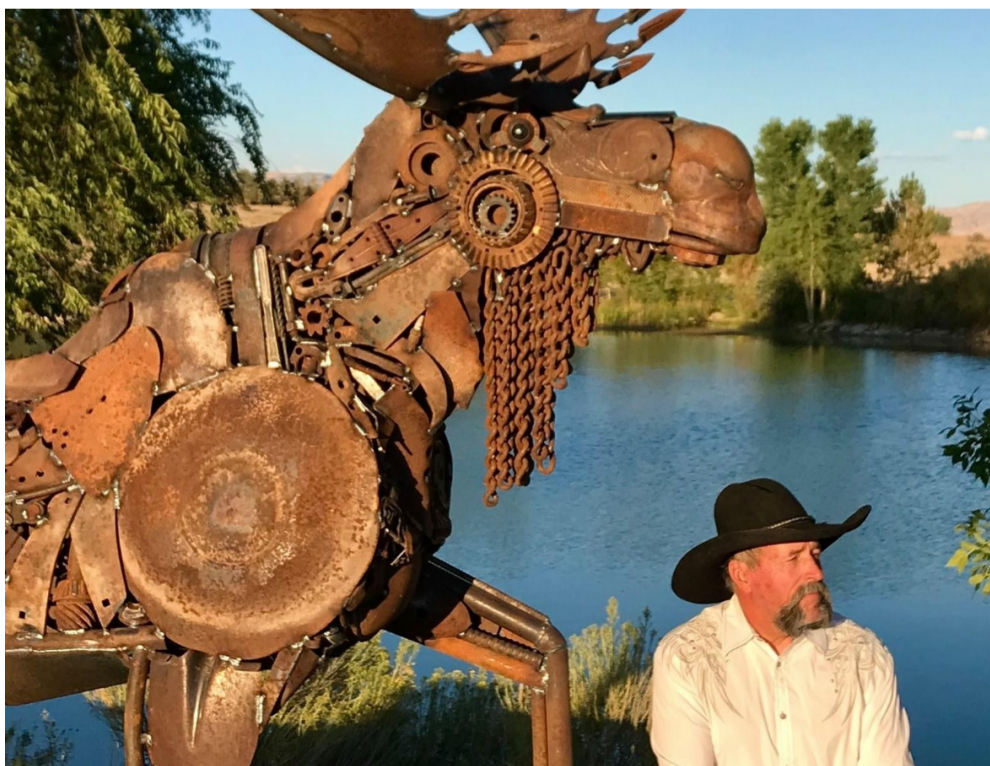

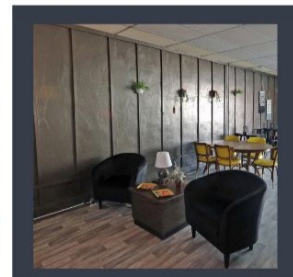

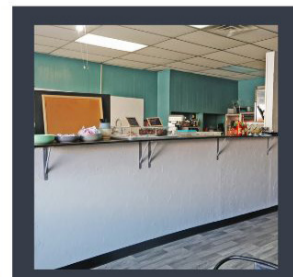
