VOTE FOR TRUSTEE REPLACEMENT ON TUESDAY NIGHTS AGENDA

The town of Hennessey is waiting with anticipation, as the board of trustees prepares to make a decision regarding the town trustee position. With the recent vacancy left by Clif Vogt, the board is set to vote on a replacement to fill the void and also vote for mayor, which Harold Shaw (vice Mayor) has filled until five board members could vote on that position. The decision is expected to be made at yesterday's Tuesday meeting (not in time for the paper) but if a candidate cannot be agreed on, it will be taken to a vote of the town in the general election in April 2025.

The candidates hoping for the position include Mark Smith, Michael Grace, Regina Wanzer, Tim Riddle, Frank Patton, and Logan Tillman, all of these residents are willing to give their time and each one has their own ideas, so choosing the right candidate makes the decision an important one for the future direction of Hennessey.

The selection process will be carefully considered, with the board looking to choose a candidate who not only meets the residency requirements within Hennessey's city limits but also shows a deep commitment to serving the town.

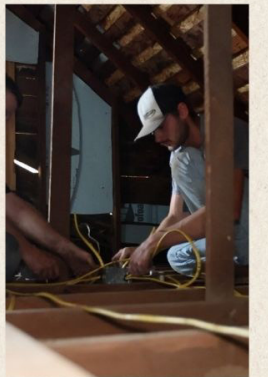

Fried Squash

Next up in our "Garden Eats" series is our mama's recipe for battered and fried squash. Please don't knock this one until you try it. It is such a summertime treat! With the summertime coming to a close and school starting up, treat yourself to this delicious side.

Batter for fried squash:

- 1 c flour
- 1 tsp baking powder
- 1 tsp salt
- 1 egg
- 1 c milk
- ¼ c salad oil (vegetable oil)



Mix all together until it resembles pancake batter.

Wash your squash and slice them into uniform-sized slices, approximately 3/8" thick. Dredge the slices of squash in flour before coating with batter and adding to a hot skillet of oil. Allow the oil to become nice and hot before adding your squash. Do not overcrowd the skillet. Cook the squash for a few minutes on each side, until browned. The actual time will depend on how hot your oil is and how browned you want your squash. Remove from the hot oil and set on a plate layered with paper towels to soak off the excess grease.

Try not to burn your mouth when trying these. They are soooo good!

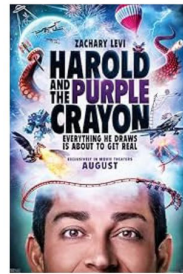

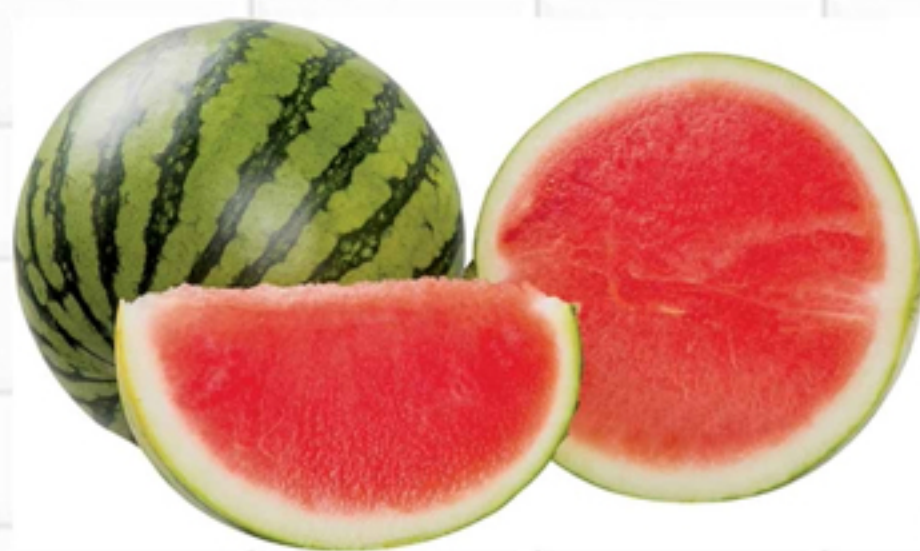
