#### Fried Squash

Next up in our "Garden Eats" series is our mama's recipe for battered and fried squash. Please don't knock this one until you try it. It is such a summertime treat! With the summertime coming to a close and school starting up, treat yourself to this delicious side.

Batter for fried squash:

- 1 c flour
- 1 tsp baking powder
- 1 tsp salt
- 1 egg
- 1 c milk
- ¼ c salad oil (vegetable oil)

Mix all together until it resembles pancake batter.

Wash your squash and slice them into uniform-sized slices, approximately 3/8" thick. Dredge the slices of squash in flour before coating with batter and adding to a hot skillet of oil. Allow the oil to become nice and hot before adding your squash. Do not overcrowd the skillet. Cook the squash for a few minutes on each side, until browned. The actual time will depend on how hot your oil is and how browned you want your squash. Remove from the hot oil and set on a plate layered with paper towels to soak off the excess grease. Try not to burn your mouth when trying these. They are soooo good!


She has been on a travel team for four years. Jerzie and her travel team have played all over the state of Oklahoma and into Kansas. Jerzie has played five positions






