The Hennessey Eagles coming off a tough rivalry loss in week one vs the Longhorns needed a bounce back game against the Tigers. Early in the game it didn't seem that they get the break they needed, as the Tigers started out converting three 3rd and long situations to punch it into the end zone for a 7-0 lead on the first drive. The Eagles did respond well though, with Hunter Weber bringing in a receiving touchdown, but a failed 2pt conversion made the ball game 7-6 Tigers. 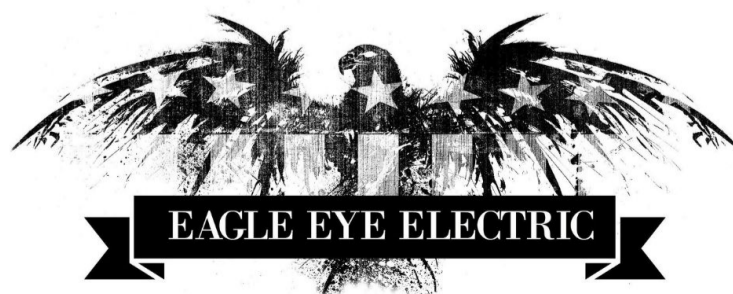
## HENNESSEY 7TH & 8TH GRADE VOLLEYBALL

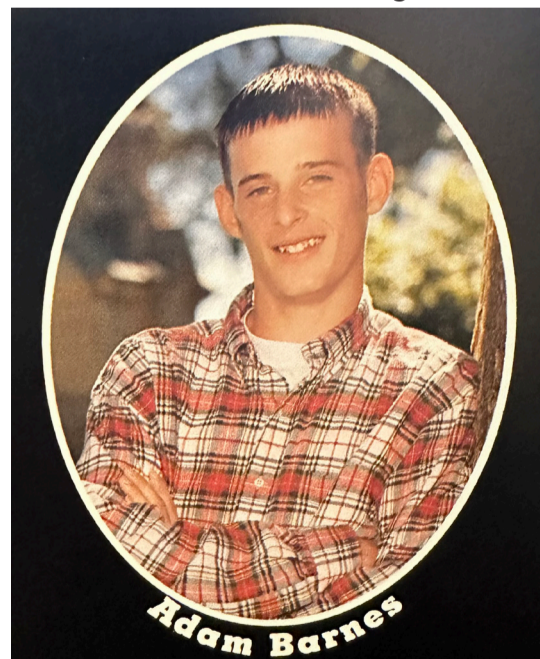
## Where are they now? Adam Barnes

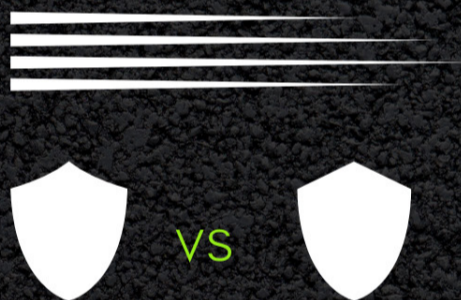
