FIRE A LITTLE TO CLOSE TO HOME



When Heather Hawk arrived back home, she was greeted by thick smoke in the air. Unsure of what was burning, she felt relief knowing it wasn't her own house that was on fire. The incident took place on Saturday, September 21st, close to the 2770 and 630 intersection, where a track hoe unintentionally struck some power lines. This led to blown fuses, sparking a grass fire that quickly spread about a quarter mile north to the Hawk Farm. The fire ended up engulfing 22 hay bales on the farm. Nova's Journey Home: A Heartbreaking Tale of Survival and Redemption

Hazel Family Reunites with a Bulldog after almost seven years ordeal in Puppy Mills

In a story of resilience and hope, We have been reunited with our English Bulldog, Nova, nearly 7 years after she was separated from us. Nova's journey is a stark reminder of the harsh realities of puppy mills and the importance of responsible pet ownership.

In 2018, Nova was sold to a buyer in Fort Madison, Iowa, who promised a loving home on a ranch. But in reality, Nova was instead shuffled through multiple puppy mills, forced to endure unimaginable conditions and produce litter after litter.

Her path winding through various mills, to then later be auctioned off. Nova changed hands multiple times, bearing witness to the darkest aspects of the industry. Her luck changed when Heidi and Brian, a compassionate couple from Wisconsin, rescued her from an online listing. They picked her up and she had scars, very sick and seemed to have been drugged with something.

SHERIFF CHRIS WEST OF THE NATIONAL SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION SPEAKS IN HENNESSEY

On Monday, September 23, at The Hive, the Kingfisher County GOP hosted a informative border security event with guest speaker, Sheriff Chris West. Chris West is a fifth generation Oklahoman with a long history of service in law enforcement. After serving in the United States Marine Corps, he spent 28 years with the Oklahoma Department of Public Safety before becoming the elected sheriff of Canadian County in 2017. Over the course of his career, Sheriff West has accrued numerous certifications and awards, including being named the Sheriff of the Year in 2019. Sheriff West was elected to the Board of Directors of the National Sheriff's Association (NSA) in 2019, Secretary of the National Sheriffs Association in 2021, and elected to the office of 3rd Vice President of the National Sheriffs Association where he represents over 3,000 Sheriffs and 14,000 NSA members from across the nation. As a Board Member to the National Sheriff's Association, West is assigned to the NSA's Homeland Security, and Narcotics & Drug Interdiction Committees. With this first-hand experience on border security, Sheriff West shared insights and firsthand accounts from his visits to Texas, Arizona, New Mexico, and Israel. He shared many photographs taken by him personally, which shed light on the myriad of challenges faced at the border, from the realities of human trafficking to the looming threats posed by drug cartels and potential terrorist infiltration into our country. With the change of seasons we see a change in the way we cook. Cooler temperatures mean we crave warm soups, stews, and comforting, filling foods. It also means football season is back in full swing. Game day food is a whole mood! Often game day food isn't the healthiest of food options. Well, we have stumbled across a recipe for queso that has cottage cheese as the main ingredient. We know what you're thinking. But give it a chance because this queso is legitimately delicious and made of real ingredients (I mean do we really know what is in velveeta?!) and gives loads of protein!! What more can you ask for? We shall call this recipe "Queso" (heavy on the quotes).

"Queso"

- 1lb ground beef (pork, turkey, chicken) seasoned, browned, and drained.

- 1/2 cup shredded cheese
- 1 can rotel tomatoes, NOT drained

While cooking your meat, add the cottage cheese, taco seasoning, water, and shredded cheese to a blender. Summer uses her ninja beautifully for this.

Blend until completely smooth.

Add this creamy mixture into your cooked and drained meat.

Add in the can of rotel tomatoes.

Stir until all combined and warmed.

Enjoy this delicious, high protein game day food!

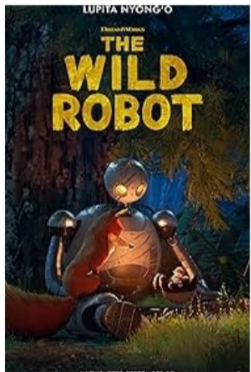
