Fall feels like family time. Time for casseroles. Time for foods that are warm: sometimes sweet, sometimes savory, sometimes ooey-goey but always delicious. This casserole is a fall take on a staple at our Christmas brunch. We love this recipe because it's simple! Not a lot of ingredients. No complicated instructions or tricks. All treats! It can even be prepped the night before, kept covered in the fridge then baked in the morning.

Pumpkin Spice French Toast Casserole

- 2 cans pillsbury cinnamon rolls
- 4 eggs
- 1/2 cup milk or coffee creamer for flavor
- 1 can of pumpkin
- 1 tsp vanilla
- 1 tsp cinnamon
- optional: add pumpkin spice to your hearts content

Preheat oven to 350. Prep 9x13 casserole dish. (Original recipe calls for spreading 2 Tbsp of butter around dish. We've had success with just using cooking spray.) Cut cinnamon rolls into pieces (6-9 depending on how big of chunks you want) then spread them evenly in casserole dish. Set aside the icing to drizzle over finished product. In a bowl: combine all other ingredients and pour over cinnamon roll pieces. It's best to continue stirring while pouring to ensure the spices don't get left behind. Bake uncovered for 30-35 minutes; until the center isn't gooey. The top should be beautifully golden *chefs kiss* Drizzle with cinnamon roll icing. Enjoy! You can absolutely eat this as is or serve with maple syrup for a little something extra. Can also top with roasted pecans if you're into that sort of thing! Disclaimer: you don't have to use coffee creamer at all. It just tends to add a bit more creamy sweetness than regular milk. We've used Cinnabon cinnamon roll creamer in the non pumpkin version and pumpkin spice latte creamer in this fall remix. If you choose to use only milk - definitely add at least a tsp of pumpkin spice to your egg mixture. We hope you enjoy the fall as much as we do! Cheers to fall comfort foods and all the baking. @okseasonedsisters

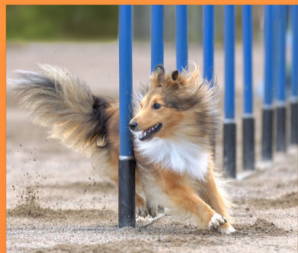
