## HENNESSEY FIRE DEPARTMENT HOLDS AWARDS CEREMONY

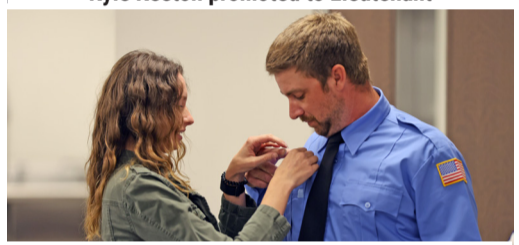

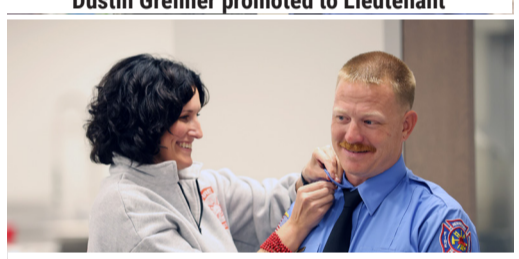

### ACCIDENT CLAIMS THE LIFE OF A HENNESSEY RESIDENT

A tragic accident claimed the life of a Hennessey resident Hayden Ryel on Wednesday afternoon in Illinois. The Clark County Coroner confirmed that Hayden, 20, was the victim in a collision on Interstate 70 between Martinsville and Marshall, Illinois. Ryel was transporting a load for a Hennessey-based company to Ohio when the accident occurred. He was also a dedicated member of the Dover Fire Department for two years. Ryel was well-regarded for his work ethic and dedication to firefighting duties.

The crash, as reported by Illinois State Police, occurred at around 4:30 p.m. near mile marker 141 in Clark County. The incident involved Ryel's F-350 pickup truck colliding with the back of a semi truck that had slowed down for a construction zone.

### Fire Cider

While it is most likely not inherently true..it implies that what we put in our bodies impacts our health. And this is undeniably true! There is much to discuss on this topic..but today I'm going to tell you about Fire Cider; the health-boosting drink that has a kick! Even Martha Stewart has shared a recipe for Fire Cider. Summer first learned about Fire Cider when she started learning more about herbs and the medicinal properties of plants. It really is fascinating. This recipe is courtesy of Mel@theherbalistspath. You can follow her on Instagram, TikTok, as well as podcasts! She is a wealth of knowledge and a great jumping off point to help you learn. This Fire Cider isn't so much a recipe as it is a method for getting the nutritional and health benefits of common foods in one powerful drink.

- fresh ginger, chopped (or dried, if necessary. Better if fresh)
- onion, chopped
- fresh garlic, chopped
- orange, chopped (unpeeled but washed)
- lemon, chopped (unpeeled, but washed)
- jalapeno, chopped
- turmeric
- whole peppercorns
- pinch of cayenne pepper
- thyme
- rosemary
- oregano
- cinnamon
- whole cloves

Prepare these ingredients and place them into mason jars (Summer uses one large ½ gallon jar). Pour raw apple cider vinegar over all until covered. Let sit 4-6 weeks, shaking gently occasionally. The apple cider vinegar will extract the medicinal/nutritional properties from the foods. After 4-6 weeks, strain out the liquid and save. You can add raw honey to sweeten, as desired. This will be shelf



stable for at least a year. You can take a tablespoon every day in the winter to boost your health, or only when you feel run down or like you are getting sick. Give that immune system a boost. Some even use it as a salad dressing or as a marinade. The benefits are there! This information is not intended to treat or cure medical problems. ## INTEGRIS HEALTH LAUNCHES 'PILLOWCASE' PROJECT



The Pillowcase Project, led by the INTEGRIS Health Enid Volunteer Services Auxiliary Program, aims to provide a comforting and personalized experience by offering each new patient a special pillowcase during their stay to take home with them upon discharge.

The auxiliary plays a crucial role in this initiative, generously sewing the linens and donating them to the Pillowcase Project. The need for this partnership and the pillowcases arose when requests for thicker, more comfortable pillows were received through patient surveys and weekly rounding reports.

After reviewing these concerns, Steve Atwood, director of behavioral health at INTEGRIS Health Meadowlake, submitted the materials change for consideration to INTEGRIS Health Enid Hospital's Chief Nursing Officer, Kenna Wilson.

"Kenna and I coordinated with the hospital's environmental services department, who helped us find another option," says Atwood. "The request was approved to move forward with purchasing the thicker pillows to replace the current pillows within the facility. During this time, Kenna mentioned how it would be nice for the patients to have a personal pillowcase they could use while they are here and take home with them."

Not every pillowcase is the same. Each linen has been individually sewn with love and care. "We currently have a handful of volunteers who have shown interest in the Pillowcase Project and were the ones who sewed and donated the current pillowcases we have for the program," says Amanda Jordan, manager of volunteer services and gift shop at INTEGRIS Health Enid Hospital. "Individuals who may not have the ability to dedicate volunteer time at our facilities, in person, now have an additional opportunity to help."

"Something as simple as a pillowcase can be a blessing most of us probably take for granted," Wilson says. "For some of our patients having a pillowcase of their own at home is a luxury."
