# Chicken Casserole (Turkey in our case)

Do you over-do-it a little bit at Thanksgiving? Yeah, same here! But boy do we love leftovers...Autumn is something of a remix champ, haha. And Summer found a casserole recipe that is certainly going to be on repeat in her house. Yum! Read on for great uses of any leftover TURKEY, HAM, BROCCOLI-CHEESE-RICE, and CHEESY POTATOES! Do you make that cheesy-broccoli-rice dish? Then you might have some of that jarred cheese called cheez wiz in your house. This first recipe is a casserole and it calls for a half a jar of cheez wiz. Listen, Summer had never in her life cooked with cheez wiz...buttttt she tried this recipe as it is and man o man is it delicious!! Go ahead and grab a box of chicken flavored Rice a Roni while you're at the grocery store too. You will not regret this. Here are some ideas to keep in mind for your Thanksgiving leftovers!

Chicken Casserole (turkey in our case!)

- 1 box chicken flavored Rice a Roni cook according to box instructions
- 1 can cream of chicken soup
- 1 cup sour cream (8 oz)
- 8 oz Cheez Wiz (heat in microwave with lid off for a few seconds to make it easier to combine)
- 2 cans French style green beans, drained

Leftover turkey

Topping:

1 sleeve buttery crackers, crushed

½ stick butter, melted

Preheat oven to 350\*F while making the Rice a Roni according to the box instructions. Grab a casserole dish and grease it up. While the rice is cooking, combine the cream of chicken, sour cream, and cheez wiz in a large bowl. Add the drained green beans to the mix, gently. Add in your leftover turkey and combine gently. Once rice is cooked, go ahead and stir that into your mix as well. You can add broth if you feel like you need it thinned, Summer didn't need to add any. Bake at 350 for 15-20 minutes.

For the topping...while the casserole is baking, combine the crushed crackers and the melted butter and then pour over the top of the casserole. Bake for another 15 minutes to brown the topping.

This just sounds like a vintage recipe and we are here for it. It's so good!

Autumn doesn't really use recipes but here are some suggestions that she likes: If you do make the aforementioned cheesy-broccoli-rice dish and have leftovers, just thin it with some chicken broth to make a soup! And add some leftover turkey to make it hearty. Yum! And ridiculously easy.

Like every red-blooded American family, ours has a love of cheesy casseroles lol. Another leftover shortcut we like to make-over is cheesy potatoes. By simply adding leftover ham, you have a ready made casserole that is soooo good! Just chunk up the leftover ham and stir it into the cheesy potatoes. Bake in the oven at 350 until all combined well, approximately 15-20 minutes.




