NO LOITERING ON SCHOOL OR TOWN PROPERTY

In recent months, there have been reports of both Hennessey students and adults loitering in the town pool parking lot, where fights have occurred. Both the town and the school are actively working to deter this behavior within the town limits and on school grounds.

On December 5th, Hennessey Superintendent Jason Sternberger addressed the issue in a letter to the board of education, outlining the steps being taken to prevent such activities on school property. The letter mentioned the placement of "No Loitering" signs in the parking lots, with consequences for students found hanging out on school premises when they shouldn't be.

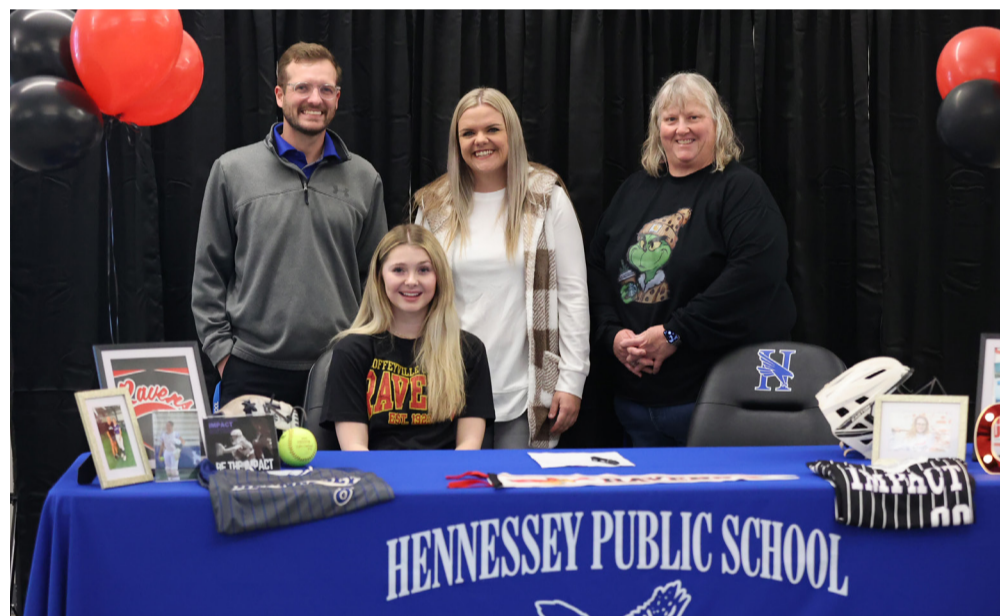
Additionally, the town of Hennessey has taken action by ordering the installation of "No Loitering" signs in all town-owned parks and properties. It is important to note that regular school and park activities during operating hours will remain unchanged.

The legal definition of Loitering is; "Loitering is the act of remaining in a public or private place for an extended period without a clear or pressing reason. It can be defined as lingering, hanging around, or idling."

Letter to the editor



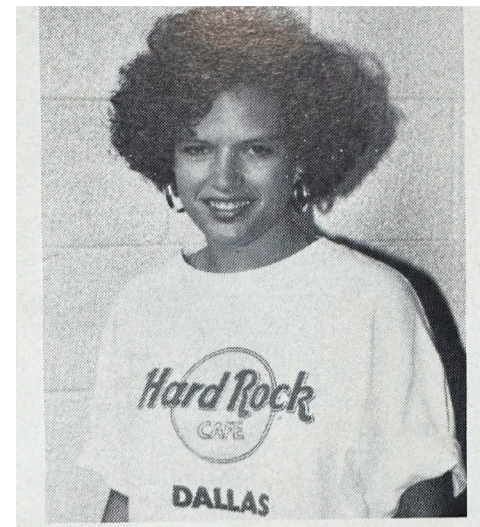

The Wonder of the Incarnation

Familiarity can often be the enemy of wonder. We can become so USED to seeing things - even important things - that they fade into the background. Christmas can be like that. Even if you don't come from a churchy family, you're probably familiar with the characters: Mary, Joseph and Baby Jesus. Angels, shepherds, and wise men. If you aren't careful, familiarity can numb you to the significance of what the incarnation (God becoming a person) truly means. Too often, the Christmas story can become part of the decor, a familiar seasonal sight that is more nostalgic than transformative.

In the book of Philippians, the apostle Paul highlights the significance of the Christmas story: "Adopt the same attitude as that of Christ Jesus, who, existing in the form of God, did not consider equality with God as something to be exploited. Instead he emptied himself by assuming the form of a servant, taking on the likeness of humanity. And when he had come as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedience to the point of death - even to death on a cross" (Phil. 2:5-8 CSB). In these verses, Paul explains the magnitude of Christ's coming to earth. Jesus laid aside his heavenly glory (emptied himself), took up human weakness (taking on the likeness of humanity), and embraced a criminal's cross for the sake of sinners. Notice the depths of Jesus's humility! He was (and is!) God, yet chose to lay aside his heavenly privileges to become one of us, live for us, suffer for us, and die for us.

The wonder of the fullness of God being contained within human form boggles the mind. It's like trying to stuff the sun into a flashlight - it doesn't work from a human perspective. Yet, this is the THEOLOGY of Christmas. The incarnation of Jesus isn't for mere intellectual musings, but is grounds for wonder and worship. Our best Christmas Carols guide us well: "Veiled in flesh the God-head see; hail th'incarnate Deity, pleased as man with men to dwell, Jesus, our Emmanuel." There is glory here, if we have eyes to see it.

This Christmas, maybe you feel the numbness of familiarity. As you attend festivities, decorate your house, and even go to church, there is a feeling of going through the motions. You've seen this all before. Consider again that baby in a manger. Look beyond the story to the significance of what God truly did that day, 2,000 years ago in Bethlehem. God brought Himself low, so that we might be lifted up. He made Himself poor, so that we could know the riches of heaven (2 Cor. 8:9). He stepped out of heaven and, in grace, reached all the way down.

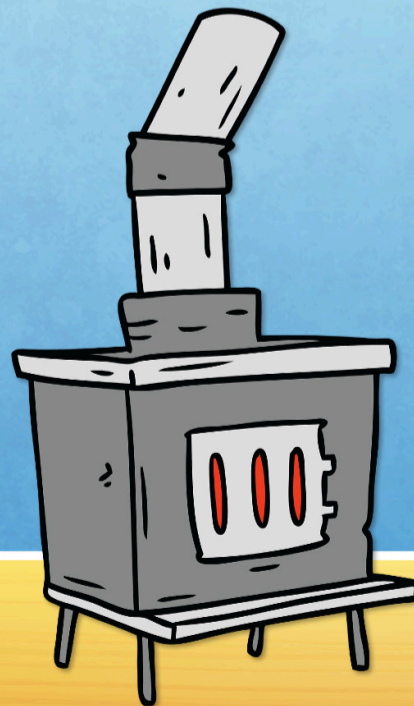


