Before the Storm

RAIN, WIND, AND HAIL SATURDAY



Saturday started off a bit chilly but quickly warmed up to 87°F by the afternoon. This rapid temperature change prompted a line of thunderstorms that, by 11 p.m., appeared to be dying out as they approached Hennessey. However, around 11:30 p.m., everything changed as the storms surged in like a lion, bringing strong winds and small hail.

Winds exceeding 50 mph damaged a small portable building at the intersection of Hwy 81 and 650 (Exxon Rd). CHS reported damage, and part of the roof was blown off a building at

524 E. Jack Choate Ave. Power outages were reported south of town, and several vehicles were reported off the road.

In January 2025, students in grades 7–12 at Hennessey had the honor of participating in the Journey of Hope program, presented by the Oklahoma City National Memorial and Museum. As part of this experience, Hennessey FFA was gifted a sapling from the Survivor Tree—an enduring symbol of hope and resilience from the Oklahoma City bombing.



The planting was delayed until weather allowed, and on March 28, that day finally arrived. With support from the Oklahoma Forestry Services, FFA members and student leaders came together to plant the sapling just north of the Auditorium.

In addition to the tree, the Oklahoma City National Memorial and Museum presented Hennessey Schools with a commemorative stone inscribed with the words Spreading Our Branches and the date April 19, 1995. FFA students are now creating a special place to install the stone, which will be lit at night as a tribute to its significance.

As this sapling grows, may it serve as a daily reminder—not only of the events of April 19, 1995—but of the strength, resilience, and hope that continue to shape our community and our future.

But, there was still a desire in her heart for her own babies which led to a journey including ovulation timing, temperature monitoring, IUI (IntraUterine Insemination), IVF (InVitro Fertilization), and adoption. This journey also included lots of unsolicited advice she had not quite anticipated... infertility is such a personal thing- the number of strangers willing to offer their opinion and "solutions" was unbelievable and unwelcome. Because, trust her, if YOU thought it would work to get her pregnant, she had tried it! She even tried to "relax and not worry about it" because that advice was given countless times. Be careful with your well-meant advice that you give to people. It isn't always as nice as you think. Try not to ask people when they are going to have kids. You never know why they don't have them already and "advice" can possibly be more damaging than helpful. As sweetly delivered as the advice might be, it just hurts to hear that something actually worked for somebody else. It's hard to talk about but sooo important. Crazy enough an infertility awareness post on social media led to opening a door to adoption which was previously an option never explored. Adopting Silas led to the beginning of her very own nuclear family. We would like to bring adoption to the table to remind everyone that it is a beautiful way to make a family. If your "problem" is the opposite of infertility please be open to adoption. It is a wonderful gift to so many loving families. But Autumn's story didn't end with adoption. She has a beautiful family that was created with the assistance of IVF along with adoption(s).

Content warning: Buckle up buttercup, we're getting real and talking reproduction. There may be some words that make you uncomfortable. In all seriousness, we're talking about a sensitive topic <Infertility, so reader discretion is advised.

There are many causes of infertility, and this article is not meant to be an inclusive list of reasons but rather to shed light on the issue in honor of April being National Infertility Awareness Month. According to the CDC, infertility in women is defined as not being able to get pregnant (conceive) after at least 1 year of unprotected *segs*.

Autumn is the OKSeasonedSister that has walked the infertility journey. She's your girl if you need someone to talk to about it, she understands what you're going through.

Autumn grew up playing house with baby dolls, barbies or not saying she's weird but she did even swaddle her cat and take him on walks in a stroller. Are you sensing a theme here? She's always known she wanted to be a mother. So the surprise of a lifetime came when she'd grown up, got married and was ready to have a baby but a baby never came.
