They walked up and down downtown leaving tiny figurines and uplifting chalk messages in front of local businesses. The goal? Brighten someone's day, share a




little love, and maybe remind folks that faith doesn't always show up with a megaphone sometimes it looks like a sidewalk message or a plastic Jesus by the door.

Enter local mud-wrangler Mark Croka, who rolled in (probably with four-wheel drive and a rope) and saved the day.


Because in Oklahoma, it's not snow or rain that stops the mail it's mud. And even that didn't stand a chance.


