KINGFISHER COUNTY ½-CENT SALES TAX RENEWAL

On Tuesday, November 18th, Kingfisher County voters passed the renewal of the ½-cent county sales tax first approved in 1991. This tax has played a significant role in supporting county services. Renewal keeps the overall tax rate the same, with adjustments only to how the funds are distributed.

For more than three decades, this revenue has been essential to local operations. Before the tax was implemented, many departments, particularly rural fire services, faced serious funding shortages, outdated equipment, and limited resources for repairs or replacements. The tax has helped modernize equipment, improve ISO ratings, and lower insurance costs for many homeowners. Continuing the tax ensures these services remain supported throughout Kingfisher County. The new Hennessey Fire Departments brush truck was paid for with this tax.



Updated Distribution of Funds

- Road Resurfacing: was 28%, now 19%
- Fire Departments: was 13% now 15%
- OSU Extension & 4-H: was 8% now 7%
- Free Fair: was 6% now 3%
- Museum: was 4% now 5%
- Libraries (Kingfisher & Hennessey): was 2% now 3%
- Sheriff's Office: was 15% now 10%
- County 911: 9% (unchanged)
- General Government: was 15% now 7%
- Jail Trust Authority: now 22%

Election Results, November 18th

All 12 precincts reported, with 648 total ballots cast:

- 464 votes (71.60%), For the Proposition
- 184 votes (28.40%), Against the Proposition

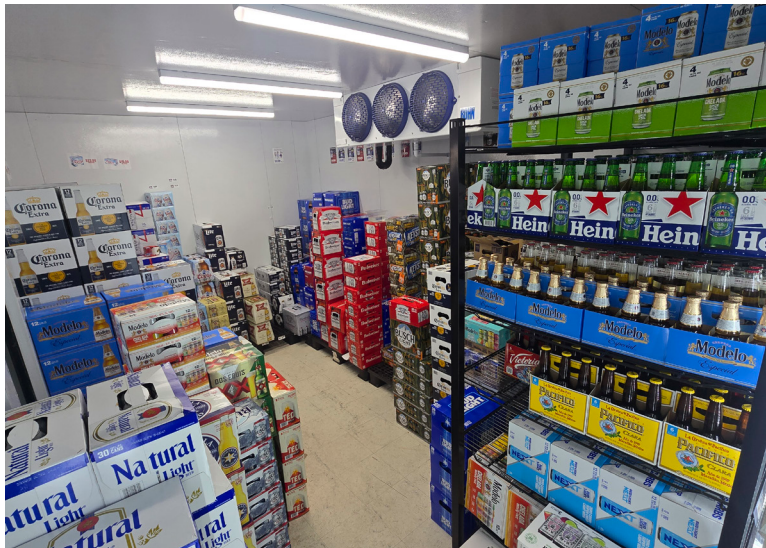
EAGLE MART ADDS BEER CAVE & NEW BATHROOM

TYREL MCLANE BUILDS M6 WRECKER & RECOVERY FROM THE GROUND UP

What began as a risky idea and two worn-out tow trucks has grown into one of central Oklahoma’s most dependable recovery services. Tyrel McLane, owner of M6 Wrecker & Recovery, turned determination and hard work into a thriving operation serving Kingfisher, Blaine County, and beyond.

Originally from Binger, McLane moved to Kingfisher as a child when his mother, a nurse, relocated for work. He spent much of his career in the tire and oil industries, including years at K&S Tire and later TerraStar, before taking a leap of faith into the towing world.

“When the local wrecker owners retired, a trooper friend told me I’d be perfect for it,” McLane recalled. “I went to my banker, told him I needed \$120,000, and that’s how it started.”

McLane’s first trucks were far from glamorous; one came from Iowa, the other from Texas, but they got the job done. Four years later, M6 now runs seven trucks, including two semis, and covers everything from car crashes to heavy-duty recovery work. “Rainy season keeps us hopping,” he said. “We pulled 43 semis in one week this year.”

Beyond his business success, McLane is known for community involvement. He regularly assists law enforcement with search and rescue efforts and is investing in a thermal drone to aid recovery operations. “If someone needs help, we try to be there,” he said.

While McLane dreams of one day owning a million-dollar rotator wrecker like those featured on Pepe’s Towing, he remains focused on building a sustainable business grounded in reliability and service. “I’ll own one someday,” he smiled. “But for now, we’re just grateful to do what we love and help people when they need it most.” You can catch the full episode of this webcast on allabouthennessey.com

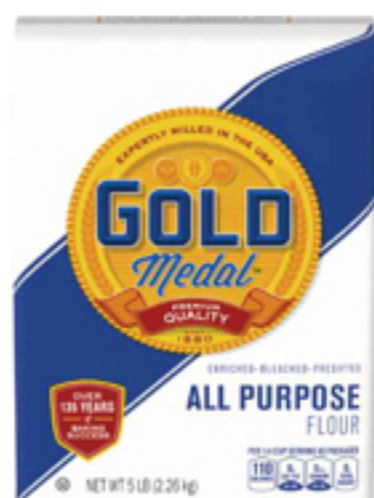
