Commissioner Sparks noted that while there's still some finishing work to be done, most of the projects are nearing completion. He expressed appreciation to residents for their patience during the construction process.



KINGFISHER COUNTY 1/2 SALES TAX CONTINUATION

The Kingfisher County fire departments are asking for you to vote Yes, on the continuation of the half cent sales tax. Since it began in 1991 the half cent sales tax has proven to be very beneficial to the county departments. It is very vital to the fire departments to purchase and maintain equipment, gear, and for training. It als-o assists with being able to pay normal bills to keep the fire departments in operation. The purchase of a new brush truck, equipped, is around \$180,000-\$200,000. The cost to outfit a firefighter in bunker gear is around \$5000 per firefighter. The Self Contained Breathing Apparatus(SCBA) is also around \$8000 per set. We try to take advantage of as much free training as we possibly can but not all training is free. For example, an Extrication A class is around \$6000. An extrication B class is another \$6000, and we have to provide the vehicles for each. Sometimes we are very fortunate to have donors help with this. Through grants obtained by various departments or from the Oklahoma State Firefighters Association, we are able to do a lot of this training at no cost. 


