

Live Like Dorothy

When someone you love becomes a memory, those memories become a treasure.

When the temperatures plunge, I tend to turn to baking. One of my favorite recipes is banana nut bread — a recipe gifted to me by

Mrs. Dorothy Burns, who passed away in 2020. Dorothy left my sons and me with a lifetime of cherished memories.

Many of those memories were made on mountain trips with Dorothy, her daughter Linda, and their family. Ski trips meant a packed van and plenty of food lovingly prepared by Dorothy. There was fried chicken, deviled eggs, and carefully packed dishes ready for a three-in-the-morning picnic while driving through the mountains of Colorado. Those meals felt like celebrations on wheels.

I've often said Mrs. Dorothy was my version of a modern-day Southern belle, and her cooking was proof of that. I never once saw her with a hair out of place. She came from an era of ironed pillowcases and starched collars. She played basketball, was homecoming queen in Cashion, and married the love of her life just one month after graduating in 1949. Together, they celebrated 70 years of marriage.

Dorothy retired after 41 years with the City of Kingfisher, beginning in the water department and later serving as city clerk. One of my favorite memories is hearing her respond to her daughter with a drawn-out, affectionate, "Uuuuwee, Linny!" It always brought a smile.

Although Linda and I have been friends for many years, my first connection to the family came even earlier. Growing up in Hennessey, I was a Rainbow Girl, and Dorothy's sister, Betty Frazier, was our leader.

Then there was my unforgettable first encounter with Dorothy's son, Bob — a story my sons still laugh about. I was a single mom at the time, giving art lessons to a group of talented women who graciously took me under their wing. One October evening, my mom came to town to babysit while I attended class. After class, she took my boys home.

Not long after, I received a phone call from my mom, clearly shaken. As she drove down Seventh Street, she said, a man in a hooded coat was waving an axe and chasing her car. I immediately called the police. The officer chuckled and said, "Oh, that's just Bob Burns."

I soon learned Bob was well-known for his elaborate Halloween decorations. My sons even visited one of his haunted garages behind the house. I still remember my youngest sprinting down




that driveway afterward — I don't think I've seen him run that fast since.

At the time, I had no idea how many friendships and memories would grow from those early moments.

Now, as I mix the ingredients for Dorothy's banana nut bread, those memories come flooding back. Once the bread has cooled, it's ready to be shared with some of my younger friends. When we lost Mrs. Dorothy, we all agreed on a simple hashtag: Live Like Dorothy.

I hope I've shared a little of that legacy — through banana nut bread and a smile.



Mix well, bring to a boil. Cover and reduce heat to simmer and allow to cook 18-20 minutes or until rice is fully cooked. Top with the shredded cheese. Replace lid and allow cheese to melt. Serve immediately!

- 1 c rice (Jasmine rice is our fav)
- 2 c cheese
- 2 c beef broth

Borrowing an old utility trailer from his family, he managed to secure his first job in Yukon, OK. His determination and testimony resonated with clients, and the work began to grow steadily.


