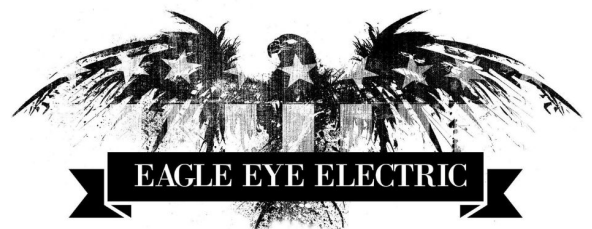

# HENNESSEY PLANS FIRST ANNUAL FREEDOM FEST CELEBRATION JULY 2

Hennessey residents will have a new tradition to look forward to this summer as the Town of Hennessey hosts its first annual Freedom Fest on Thursday, July 2. The family-friendly celebration will begin at 6 p.m. at the Hennessey High School football practice field and feature inflatables, water games, face painting, balloon animals, contests, food vendors, and activities for all ages.

A community parade will line up at 7 p.m. at the Christian Church parking lot before stepping off at 7:30 p.m. and making its way through town to the festival grounds. Highlights of the evening include a hot dog eating contest with age divisions for children, teens, and adults, a selfie wall contest, free hot dogs, watermelon, and bottled water while supplies last, and participation from local organizations including the Hennessey Police Department, Kingfisher County Sheriff's Office, Masonic Lodge, Lions Club, and numerous volunteers. Organizers say Freedom Fest was created to provide an affordable, family-friendly way for the community to come together and celebrate Independence Day.

# Major Award for the POST!


Hennessey's hometown newspaper has snagged the Perfecta Award for the second year in a row!

Communities across Oklahoma have an opportunity to brighten public spaces through the Paint Oklahoma Beautiful program, an initiative of Keep Oklahoma Beautiful that provides free exterior paint for qualifying beautification projects.

The statewide program is designed to help cities, towns, nonprofits, schools, tribal governments, civic organizations, and volunteer groups transform aging public structures with a fresh coat of paint. By restoring community landmarks, the program aims to increase civic pride while improving

the appearance of neighborhoods throughout the state.

Paint Oklahoma Beautiful supplies high-quality recycled exterior paint in a variety of natural colors, along with a stipend to help cover the cost of painting supplies. The amount of paint awarded is based on the size of the project outlined in each application.

Eligible projects include community centers, park buildings, museums, welcome signs, pavilions, historic structures, public facilities, and other highly visible buildings that serve the public. The program focuses on projects that make a lasting impact and encourage community involvement.

According to Keep Oklahoma Beautiful, a simple coat of paint can do much more than improve a building's appearance. It can inspire volunteers, strengthen community pride, encourage tourism, and breathe new life into public spaces.

After receiving their paint, participating communities complete their projects during the designated project period. Finished projects may also be recognized through the organization's annual "Communities Primed for Change" contest, with winners celebrated during Keep Oklahoma Beautiful's Environmental Excellence Celebration.

Keep Oklahoma Beautiful is a statewide nonprofit organization dedicated to empowering Oklahomans to preserve and enhance the state's natural beauty through litter prevention, beautification, environmental education, and community partnerships. The organization supports environmental efforts in all 77 Oklahoma counties and works with dozens of local affiliate organizations across the state.

Communities interested in applying for the Paint Oklahoma Beautiful program can learn more, review eligibility requirements, and submit an application through the Keep Oklahoma Beautiful website. Applications are accepted during the program's annual application period.

## MEET THE HENNESSEY FIREFIGHTERS



*Each week, the Hennessey POST will feature a member of the Hennessey Fire Department, sharing their stories, what inspired them to join the fire service, and some of the accomplishments and experiences they've had along the way.*

### **Captain Levi Copeland**

Helping people in need and serving alongside a close-knit team are what keep Captain Levi Copeland committed to the Hennessey Fire Department.

Copeland, a 2000 graduate of Hennessey High School, joined the department in August 2020. He currently serves as a captain and brings a wide range of training and experience to the department.

After high school, Copeland attended Northern Oklahoma College in Enid, earning an Associate of Applied Science degree in the Ford Asset Program. He now works as an Oilfield Chemical Technician for Cimarron Chemical Solutions.

Copeland says he joined the fire department for a straightforward reason: to help people and put out fires.

One of his favorite aspects of the fire service is the brotherhood among firefighters and the opportunity to help others during difficult times. He also enjoys participating in training and certification classes that help prepare firefighters for emergencies.

His certifications include Firefighter I and II, Hazmat Awareness, Hazmat Operations, Storm Spotter training, and EMT certification.

One call that stands out in his memory was a mutual aid response outside Enid where firefighters battled a large grass fire. Copeland recalled flames consuming everything in their path and cedar trees exploding as the fire advanced.

When he's not working or responding to emergencies, Copeland spends much of his free time keeping up with his children and their sports activities.





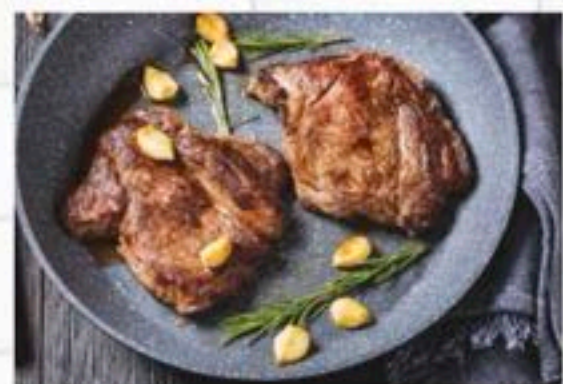
