HENNESSEY ROUND UP GO-KART RACES RETURN JULY 24-25

The sound of racing engines will once again fill the Hennessey Rodeo Grounds as the Hennessey Round Up Go-Kart Races return Friday and Saturday, July 24-25.

WEEKEND SCHEDULE The weekend kicks off Friday evening with practice runs from 8 to 10 p.m. Drivers can participate for \$10 per kart, and once practice wraps up, the Logan County Badlands Band will provide live entertainment.

SATURDAY EVENTS Saturday begins with breakfast at 8 a.m., followed by a meet and greet from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the Hennessey Swimming Pool, where sandwiches will be provided. The main event gets underway at 7 p.m. as racers from around the region compete on the track.

ADMISSION AND AMENITIES Admission is \$10 for adults, children ages 5 and under are admitted free, and pit passes are available for \$30. A concession stand and a beer garden for guests 21 and older will also be available throughout the event.

VISITOR INFORMATION Visitors traveling to Hennessey for the races can find information about local lodging, restaurants, shopping, and attractions by visiting allabouthennessey.com/discoverhennessey.

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HENNESSEY FIRE DEPARTMENT PREPARES NEW COMMAND UNIT FOR SERVICE



The Hennessey Fire Department is putting the finishing touches on its new Command Unit, which is expected to enter service soon.

The vehicle is owned by the Town of Hennessey and began its life as a Life EMS ambulance. After being retired from EMS service several years ago, it was assigned to the Hennessey Fire Department at no cost.

Former Fire Chief Bert Gritz initially developed a plan to repurpose the vehicle, but construction of the fire station addition took priority for several years.

Fire Chief Brandon Scott said the department spent considerable time developing a plan to convert the former ambulance into a vehicle that would better meet the department's needs. Following the incident involving Loyal Fire Department firefighter Ty Gardner last year, it became clear that a dedicated command vehicle like this was needed.

"The conversion project was funded through Kingfisher County rural fire tax dollars that are distributed to all fire departments in Kingfisher County," Scott said. "This funding has nothing to do with the recently approved 522 Ambulance District or the Town of Hennessey's budget."

The Command Unit recently returned from the outfitter with a fresh coat of paint and several functional upgrades. This week, the team at Royal Signs completed the vehicle's graphics, and radio equipment is expected to be installed in the coming days.

One of the unit's most notable features is an exterior video monitor that allows incident commanders to view the locations of fire apparatus and other emergency vehicles operating at the scene via GPS. The added technology will help improve coordination and communication during emergency responses.

Although it was once an ambulance, the vehicle will not be used for patient transport. Instead, it will serve as a mobile command center at fires, severe weather incidents, and other emergency scenes.

The unit will also function as a rehabilitation station for firefighters and other first responders, providing a place to cool down, rehydrate, and recover from heat and physical exertion during extended emergency operations. Photos by AAH Jack Quirk

Hennessey Firefighter Spotlight: Luis Lara

For Luis Lara, becoming a firefighter wasn't about recognition. It was about helping others.

Lara joined the Hennessey Fire Department in 2024 with a simple goal, to make a difference when his community needs it most. "I wanted the chance to help others," he said.

A 2001 graduate of Hennessey High School, Lara works as a warehouse manager in his day job. When the pager goes off, however, he trades the warehouse for bunker gear and responds as a firefighter with the Hennessey Fire Department. He has earned both his Fire I certification and Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) certification, giving him the training to assist with both fire and medical emergencies.

When asked what he enjoys most about serving, Lara didn't talk about the excitement of emergency calls. Instead, he pointed to the people beside him. "My favorite thing about the fire service is the brotherhood, the bond with everyone at the station," he shared.

Like many volunteer firefighters, Lara balances family, work and community service. Away from the fire station, he enjoys spending time with family and friends and going coyote hunting.

The Hennessey Fire Department is made up of dedicated volunteers like Lara who answer the call at all hours of the day and night. Whether responding to fires, vehicle accidents, medical emergencies or storms, they serve because they care about their neighbors.



HENNESSEY UNITED PREPARES FOR RENAMED WINE FESTIVAL, COMMUNITY PROJECTS

Members of Hennessey United met Thursday, July 16, to continue planning several community events and projects, with much of the discussion centered on this fall's annual wine festival.

The group voted to rename the longtime Wine and Chocolate Festival as the Hennessey Wine Festival, with the tagline, "Wine, Beer & Spirits." The event will be held from noon to 6 p.m. on October 3. The board discussed vendor requirements, promotional plans, rain contingency options, and event logistics. Booth fees will remain \$25, and vendors will be encouraged to offer chocolate- or wine-related items. Organizers also plan to limit the number of food vendors to help ensure each has a successful day.

Jack Quirk, representing Discover Hennessey, said promotions will include updated printed materials, Eventbrite ticket sales with a QR code, targeted social media advertising, and the possibility of new, large welcome flags to attract visitors.

Members also reviewed several community improvement projects. Renee Curry reported that volunteers have placed 36 flower pots along Main Street this season, with beautification expenses totaling about \$460, below the annual budget. Jack Quirk of Discover Hennessey announced that a new 4-by-8-foot Town-Wide Garage Sale banner is complete and ready for use.

Additional discussion included planning for upcoming go-kart races, ideas for decorating the community cowboy hat display, Christmas parade participation, and organizational matters, including establishing official electronic payment accounts and appointing a co-treasurer.

The next Hennessey United meeting is scheduled for Thursday, Aug. 13, at 6 p.m. at Vernost Wine, 110 N. Main St., Hennessey.

Thank you to everyone who came out, gave, and showed up. Dana would be proud of the town she loved so much.



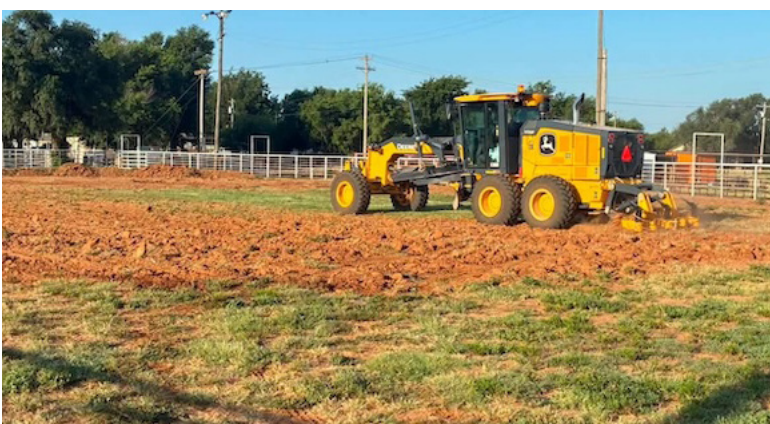
GETTING READY TO RACE

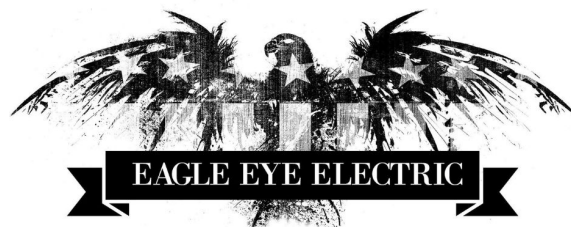
General admission is \$10 each night, and children 5 and under are admitted free. See the full details in the full page ad in this paper.

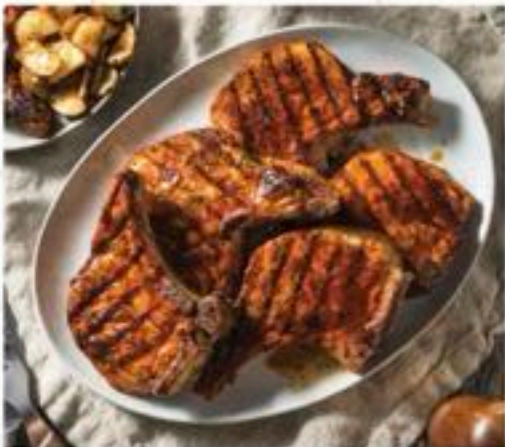
